Fly the Routes - Save HTO

All points must be flown precisely for noise abatement. Areas shaded in red are noise sensitive, should be avoided whenever safe and feasible.

2 Arrival Routes:

- November Route (primary)
- Echo Route

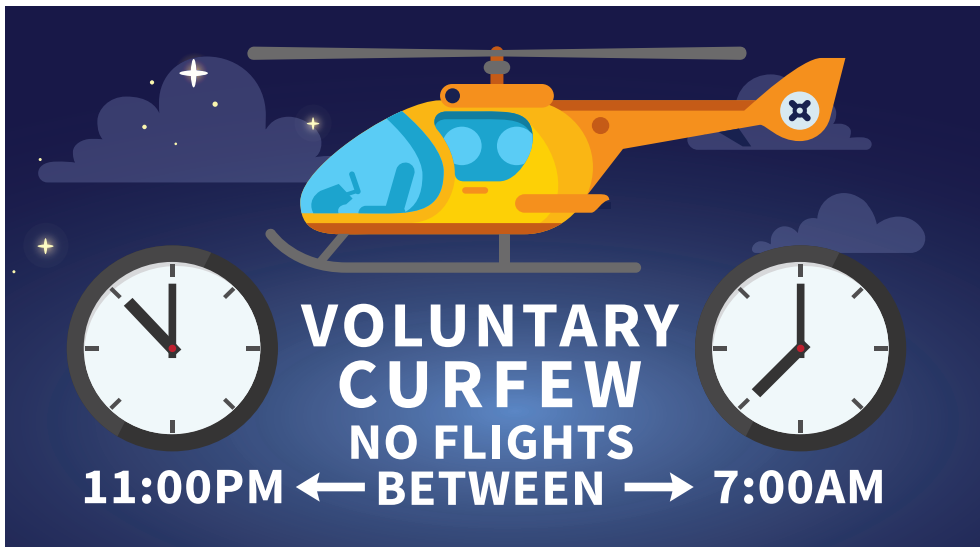
3 Departure Routes:
